Thank you for booking into one or more of our events at Classic Shows. Please find enclosed relevant passes for the show(s) you have booked to attend — you will receive no further correspondence from Classic Shows.

Please distribute passes as necessary. Distribution of club passes prior to the event is the responsibility of the club stand co-ordinator, NOT by the organiser at the gate on the day of the event. The occupants of vehicles arriving without passes will be charged the normal visitor rate and NO refunds will be issued. PLEASE do not lose your passes. **Please note that passes are valid until 11am on the day of the event, exhibitors arriving after this time will be charged the normal admission price.**

- Dogs are generally allowed on site on a lead at all venues, but please check the website www.classicshows.org.
- All events are fully signposted. Follow the hi-vis yellow road signs located around the venue, which direct you to the event.
- Exhibitor gates open at 7am on event day. At most venues exhibitors can set up between 2pm – 7pm on the day before the event, but please check the Classic Shows website at www.classicshows.org / ring the office on 01484 667776 to confirm.
- Display and trade vehicles are to be in place by 9:30am. Clubs and private entry vehicles to be in place by 11am.
- Please take directions from our stewards who are there to assist you and maintain site health and safety.
- Exhibitor camping is available at some venues for £10 per tent/caravan/motorhome per night. Traders can stay on site / in their vehicles at no extra charge at most events. For more information on camping, please call the office on 01484 667776.
- No advertising notices permitted on enthusiasts' pre-booked vehicles. To advertise your vehicle for sale contact 01484 667776.
- Concours: At indoor events, all vehicles will be judged in the concours. At outdoor events, if you would like to take part in the concours judging, listen out for an announcement for your vehicle's section. You will then need to drive your vehicle into the concours arena for judging.
- Concours awards are judged between 11am and the end time of the event (between 3pm or 4pm). Concours is judged by judges representing this organisation and whose decision is final.
- A unique, and free, commemorative plaque is available for all vehicle exhibitors from the commentator after the award ceremony.
- To ensure fairness, the car of the show winner will be ineligible to win car of the show at future events in the same season.
- Clubs may use our events to promote their activities and recruit new members. Clubs must display a banner or board with their name clearly indicated.
- Traders, autojumble stall holders and dealerships must have valid insurance for their stock and public liability insurance. The organiser and/or their agents do not accept any responsibility and/or liability for any loss, theft or damage to any stock or content being exhibited.
- All vehicles on site must have valid insurance covering them for theft and damage - the organiser cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to any vehicle however caused.

VENUE LOCATIONS

Bodryddan Hall Dyserth Road, Clwyd, LL18 5SB – Situated on the A5151 midway between Dyserth and Rhuddlan close to the A55. Take the St. Asaph turn off at Junction 27 and the A525 to Rhuddlan. Journey through Rhuddlan to the second roundabout and take a right. The house is signposted from here.

Capesthorpe Hall Macclesfield, Cheshire, SK11 9JY — Situated on the A34 just south of Alderley Edge in the village of Siddington. 2 miles south of the Monks Heath traffic lights.

Castle Howard York, Yorkshire, YO60 7DA — Approximately 15 miles north east of York, just off the A64. Follow the brown tourist signs.

Hardwick Hall Hotel Sedgfield, Co. Durham, TS21 2EH — Just North of the A177/A689 Roundabout at Sedgfield, a few minutes from the A1(M) Junction 60 or the A19. Follow the A177 North for 200 meters from the roundabout towards Durham and our driveway is on your left.

Thoresby Park Nr Ollerton, Notts, NG22 9EP — Thoresby Park is on the A614 Nottingham to Doncaster Road between the Ollerton R-A-B and the A1M R-A-B near Clumber Park.

Three Counties Showground Malvern, Worcs, WR13 6NW — Situated 10 miles from J7/8 of the M5 and J1 of the M50. Follow the brown tourist signs.

Weston Park Nr Telford, Shrops, TF11 8LE — Situated on the A5 at Weston-under-Lizard, just 30 minutes from Central Birmingham 3 miles off M54, Junction 3 and 8 miles off M6 Junction 12. You can also reach Weston Park via the M6 Toll Road.
